The Positions

The Foundation for Social Welfare Services invites applications for the post of full-time time Family Therapists.

The Role

The Family Therapist shall be assigned to work with situations such as family conflict, where there are addictive behaviours and/or previous abuse, violence, trauma and/or loss in families, among others. As part of his/her work, s/he shall undertake sessions with families and/or couples, attend case conferences and reviews, draw up reports and conduct assessments and consultancy amongst others.

The Family Therapist is accountable to the Leader of Psychology and Family Therapy Services, which is currently part of Agenzija Sedqa.

The Persons

The individuals applying for this post shall possess a Masters Degree in Family Therapy or are in the possession of the Diploma and are in the final stages of acquiring a Masters Degree in Family and Systemic Therapy. Until a warrant is obtained, the selected candidates will work under supervision and will be assigned to the post once a relevant warrant regulating the practice is obtained.

Eligible candidates must be fluent in Maltese and English to be eligible for an interview. Qualifications and experience claimed must be supported by certificates and/or testimonials. Applicants in possession of a foreign qualification/s are to produce with their application, a recognition statement on comparability of qualifications issued by the Malta Qualification Recognition Information Centre (MQRIC). In addition candidates are requested to submit an updated CV.
