### The Position

The Foundation for Social Welfare Services invites applications for the role of Prevention Professional with Agenzija Sedqa within the Prevention Services.

Without prejudice to the need that may arise, the selected candidate may be moved by the management to another service in accordance to the exigencies of the Foundation's services.

### The Role

The Prevention Professional shall be expected to work in the Primary Prevention team operated by Agenzija Sedqa which is committed to impart life skills within schools, community at large with the aim of assisting the general public to adopt healthy positive behaviours, away from addictions.

As an integral aspect of the post, the Professional shall be expected to work within educational settings by preparing and delivering presentations and programmes, interventions and activities as necessary that enhance positive life-styles. S/he will also assist in community events by helping the team in establishing contacts and networking with organisations, together with preparing and delivering presentations across a wide array of groups, including children, adolescents and adults in various settings ranging from school settings to youth centres. In both cases, s/he will be expected to design and create the resources that adequately reach the outcomes planned for the particular strategy as well to actively liaise with the stakeholders to refer any situation of concern which has arisen during the session to the relevant professional/service. The professional is also expected to evaluate his/her service and to be on the look out for feedback which may ameliorate his/her input, as well as the general operation of the team. The incumbent is to attend regular team meetings as stipulated by the agency's procedures, and to ensure that all administrative aspects of the job are attended to and regularly updated. In addition the person selected must be available to work for planned specific sessions after office hours as per work exigencies..

The Prevention Executive shall be directly accountable to the Leader of the Prevention Services.

### The Person

The individuals interested in this role shall be in possession of a minimum of MQF Level 6 qualification in a relevant field coupled with a minimum of one year experience in work within the social field.

Eligible candidates must be at least eighteen (18) years of age and are fluent in Maltese and English to be eligible for an interview. Qualifications and experience claimed must be supported by certificates and/or testimonials. Applicants in possession of a foreign qualification/s are to produce with their application, a recognition statement on comparability of qualifications issued by the Malta Qualification Recognition Information Centre (MQRIC). In addition, candidates are requested to submit an updated Curriculum Vitae, two (2) reference letters and a valid police conduct. Applications will be accepted till end of business day (1600hrs) of **Friday 27th of November, 2020**.
