The Positions

The Foundation for Social Welfare Services invites applications for the post of Full-time and Part Time Psychologists preferably trained and experienced in working with children or in the addiction field.

The Role

Forming part of a team, the selected candidate shall provide psychological interventions accordingly to aid service users in reaching their full potential and improve their quality of life. As part of his/her work, s/he shall perform the relevant assessments in accordance with his/her competence, undertake individual and/or group sessions, perform staff supervision as required, attend case conferences and reviews and draw up the necessary reports, amongst other duties. S/he shall also liaise with other professionals to sustain the bio-psychosocial assessments of the service users. Ideally, selected candidates should be trained to work with children but may be requested to provide their services in any sector as required by management in order to satisfy the exigencies of the FSWS adequately. The position is tied to the remuneration package as per FSWS Collective Agreement Grade 2. Terms and conditions as applicable in the Recruitment Policy No.16. .

The Persons

The individuals applying for this post shall possess a Masters Degree in any of the following:

- Clinical Psychology and hold a warrant to practice the profession of a Psychologist in Malta.
- Counselling Psychology and hold a warrant to practice the profession of a Psychologist in Malta.

Any applicants who hold a Master's degree in Psychology but who do **not hold a warrant** yet and applicants who are in their final year of studies for the qualifications listed herein this call shall also be considered. Furthermore, the selected candidates must be able to communicate both in Maltese and English to the benefit of the service user.

Qualifications and experience claimed must be supported by certificates and/or testimonials. Applicants in possession of a foreign qualification/s are to produce with their application, a recognition statement on comparability of qualifications issued by the Malta Qualification Recognition Information Centre (MQRIC). In addition, candidates are requested to submit an updated Curriculum Vitae, two (2) reference letters and a valid police conduct.
