The Position

The Foundation for Social Welfare Services invites applications for the post of Full-time **Psychotherapists/Psychologists** to work with the Foundations' **Psychological Services**.

Without prejudice to the need that may arise, the selected candidate may be moved by the management to another service in accordance to the exigencies of the Foundation's services.

The Role

The role of the professional shall primarily entail staff supervision and staff support to selected employees at the Foundation for Social Welfare Services. The chosen candidates shall work with a team of professionals to assist employees in reaching their full professional potential and improve their quality of life at work. The position is tied to the remuneration package as per FSWS Collective Agreement Grade 2. Terms and conditions as applicable in the Recruitment Policy No.16.

The Person

Individuals interested in this post must be in possession of a:

Master's Degree in the field of Psychology and be in possession of a relevant warrant that regulates the practice with the psychology and the medical professions board.

Or

Master's Degree in the field of Gestalt Psychotherapy and be in possession/or in the process of obtaining a relevant warrant that regulates the practice with the Council for the professionals complimentary to medicine.

Eligible candidates must be fluent in Maltese and English to be eligible for an interview. Qualifications and experience claimed must be supported by certificates and/or testimonials. Applicants in possession of a foreign qualification/s are to produce with their application, a recognition statement on comparability of qualifications issued by the Malta Qualification Recognition Information Centre (MQRIC). In addition, candidates are requested to submit an updated Curriculum Vitae, two (2) reference letters and a valid police conduct.
