The Position

The Foundation for Social Welfare Services invites applications for the role of a **Social Welfare Professional** within the **Agency for Community and Therapeutic Services**.

Without prejudice to the need that may arise, the selected candidate may be moved by the management to another service in accordance to the exigencies of the Foundation's services.

The Role

The Professional shall deliver **The Incredible Years®** child/parenting programme and other interventions targeted at improving; the parenting skills of parents or carers, the parent-child relationship as well as, addressing challenging behaviour of children. Such professional will form part of a team of multi-disciplinary professionals within **Home-Based Therapeutic Services**.

The Incredible Years® is a series of interlocking, evidence-based programs for parents, children, and teachers, supported by over 30 years of research. The goal is to prevent and treat young children's behaviour problems and promote their social, emotional, and academic competence. The role entails being part of a team of professionals who deliver manual-based individual home parenting programme, parenting groups and child treatment groups. In order to be able to engage multi-stressed families, the role requires flexible hours according to the clients' needs.

The position is tied to the remuneration package as per FSWS Collective Agreement Grade 4. Terms and conditions as applicable in the Recruitment Policy No.16.

The Person

The individuals interested in this role shall be in possession of a minimum of MQF level 6 qualification in Humanities, or any other equivalent and comparable qualification. Furthermore, experience in one of the helping professions: social work, psychology, psychotherapy, education, nursing, psychiatry, or experience in working with families and children is considered an asset.

Eligible candidates must be at least eighteen (18) years of age and are fluent in Maltese and English to be eligible for an interview. Qualifications and experience claimed must be supported by certificates and/or testimonials. Applicants in possession of a foreign qualification/s are to produce with their application, a recognition statement on comparability of qualifications issued by the Malta Qualification Recognition Information Centre (MQRIC). In addition, candidates are requested to submit an updated Curriculum Vitae, two (2) reference letters and a valid police conduct. Applications will be accepted till end of business day (1600hrs) of **Friday 29th of January 2021**.
