The Position

The Agency for Community and Therapeutic Services is guided by the principles of community development, based on social justice and socio-economic sustainability, and in line with the National Strategic Policy for Poverty Reduction and for Social Exclusion (Malta 2014-2024).

Hiliet il-Komunita' carries the responsibility to focus on the social dimension of the urban regeneration of lower Valletta. It is aimed at supporting communities living within the neighbourhoods demarcated by the project in reaching their socio-economic potential. The scope of the project is to offer essential practical and transferable skills development that shall assist members from the communities to benefit from positive outcomes of regeneration. This project shall focus on the parameters of Family and Parenting, Employment and Education Readiness, Housing and Household Stability, Financial Literacy and Income Stability amongst others.

The position is tied to the remuneration package as per FSWS Collective Agreement Grade 4. Terms and conditions as applicable in the Recruitment Policy No.16.

The Role

The selected person will be working at individual and community level to identify and/or outreach for individuals or groups of individuals who are in risk of poverty and social exclusion and provide mentorship on issues of employment readiness, education, housing stability, financial literacy and parenting. The person will relate to individuals' interests and passions to fuel their motivation to sustain involvement and participation in the mentoring journey. The Social Mentor will encourage and support beneficiaries to identify their own needs, set targets and plan how to achieve them in order to become as independent as possible, supported by, and contributing to, their own communities. Furthermore, the selected person will encourage and facilitate community groups to become self-supporting, independent and inclusive, while promoting social wellbeing.

The Person

Candidate must possess an MQF Level 6 qualification in Humanities or a related equivalent qualification.

Eligible candidates must be fluent in Maltese and English to be eligible for an interview. Qualifications and experience claimed must be supported by certificates and/or testimonials. Applicants in possession of a foreign qualification/s are to produce with their application, a recognition statement on comparability of qualifications issued by the Malta Qualification Recognition Information Centre (MQRIC). In addition candidates are requested to submit an updated CV and a valid police conduct. Applications will be accepted till **Friday 25th of September 2020** till end of business day (till 1600hrs).
