The Position

The Social Welfare Professional shall be assigned to a specialized service with the Human Rights Directorate to assist in developing programmes and provide services aimed at sex workers.

This program is funded by MJEG and has a duration of 36 months.

The Role

The selected person will assist in the setting up of this new service and developing of new assessment tools pertaining to this particular programmed aimed at assisting sex workers. The Social Welfare Professional will be maintaining up to date case records and statistics and complies with administrative requirements as defined by Agency's policy and procedures. The chosen candidate will ensure that service users are served with the highest professional standard through accurate assessments, professional and timely interventions and follow up. Furthermore, the Social Welfare Professional will participate in preventive work within the community, as well as prepare care plans/action plans in consultation and agreement with service users and provides one to one individual help. The position is tied to the remuneration package as per FSWS Collective Agreement Grade 4. Terms and conditions as applicable in the Recruitment Policy No.16.

The Person

The individuals interested in this role shall be in possession of a Degree in Humanities (MQF level 6) or a related equivalent qualification.

Eligible candidates must be at least eighteen (18) years of age and are fluent in Maltese and English to be eligible for an interview. Qualifications and experience claimed must be supported by certificates and/or testimonials. Applicants in possession of a foreign qualification/s are to produce with their application, a recognition statement on comparability of qualifications issued by the Malta Qualification Recognition Information Centre (MQRIC). In addition, candidates are requested to submit an updated Curriculum Vitae, two (2) reference letters and a valid police conduct. Applications will be accepted till end of business day (1600hrs) of **Friday 22nd of January, 2021**.
